**BOOKS** circulate for two weeks with two renewals

**JOURNALS** generally do not circulate

Journals that circulate are marked “3 Day Circulation”

**AUDIOVISUALS** circulate for two weeks with one renewal. AV viewing equipment is available upon request

**REFERENCE COLLECTION** resources may be used in the library

**COURSE RESERVES** shelved behind the service Desk. During the day reserve material is for IN LIBRARY USE ONLY. Reserve material can be checked out overnight two hours before library closing and returned within one hour of library opening.

## Printing & Photocopying

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### VendaCard:

- Used for printing & photocopying
- Purchase VendaCards at the Circulation Desk for \$1.00
- Add money in the Self-Service Room

### Printing:

- Printing requires a VendaCard
- Cost is 7¢/page
- For instructions, ask at the service desk

### Self-Service Photocopying:

- Copy machines are located in Self-Service Center & in the Lower Level (SB) Journal Stacks
- Cost: 7¢/page with VendaCard or 10¢/page with cash

### Copy Services:

- Photocopy request forms and pricing are available on the Library website or at the Circulation Desk
