Congratulations on your acceptance into the University of Connecticut School of Medicine/School of Dental Medicine! A carefully selected and competitively-priced high end laptop will be a required tool in your education. **Upon your arrival next August, you will receive the Lenovo ThinkPad described below as part of your equipment.** The laptop will be pre-loaded with required curricular software chosen by the faculty. It also meets the strict specifications mandated by the e-testing program used throughout your courses here. The laptop includes a 4 Year ThinkPad Protection warranty in the event that your laptop needs repairs. This laptop is itemized on your tuition and fee bill. If you receive financial aid, the cost of the laptop is included in the budget prepared by the financial aid office.
