The instructor for this class is **Donna Berryman**, Outreach Coordinator for the National Network of Libraries of Medicine, New England Region.

This free program is for public, health sciences, academic, and special librarians who want to become more familiar with searching the Medline database using PubMed. Medline is the premiere bibliographic database from the National Library of Medicine covering the fields of medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, and the healthcare system. This program is the same as the one offered in the Spring 2004 under the title - Basics of Searching PubMed. Hospital and health sciences librarians may earn 3 Medical Library Association CEU's for this course.

Learn how to: Use all of PubMed's main features to conduct more effective searches; Use Medical Subject Headings (MESH) to obtain more relevant article citations; Limit searches by date, age of subject written about, publication type, and a specific author; Limit a search to citations on complementary medicine; Combine search terms to retrieve citations for complex topics; and much more
